Context

In order to respond to the need for the Patents Portal system to evolve, our Client entrusted us with studying a solution able to allow for a more complete management of invention reports and patent reviews and a faster, more effective and flexible means of publishing and consulting guideline documents.

The aim of the solution is to give the Company the opportunity to have a database on which to record the structured information necessary for the issue of documents, and at the same time to manage the publication of guideline documents.

The solution contemplated the creation of dedicated data structures in a Microsoft Sharepoint environment for the management of invention reports and patent reviews. With this structured, indexed system, users have access to all the data in a complete database, where searches can be conducted and data extracted.

Documentation management is orchestrated by specialised workflows invention reports and patent reviews that supervise the change in status functions for approvals, refusals and reviews of data.

- Faster, more uniform production of patent documents at worldwide level.
- Filing and quick search of existing documents and documents with a similar patent context.
- Rapid, immediate access to the information available on the main databases of the patents.
